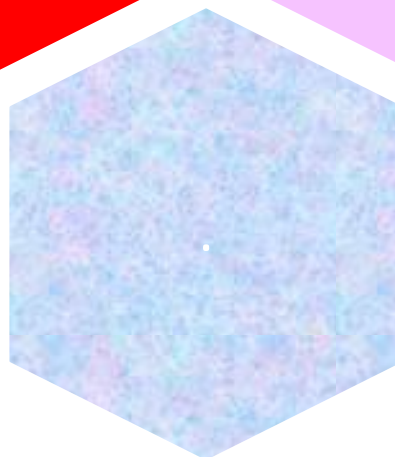
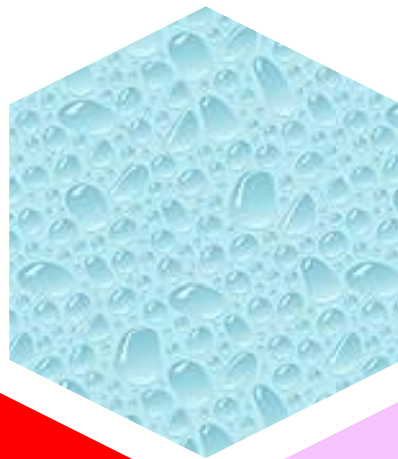
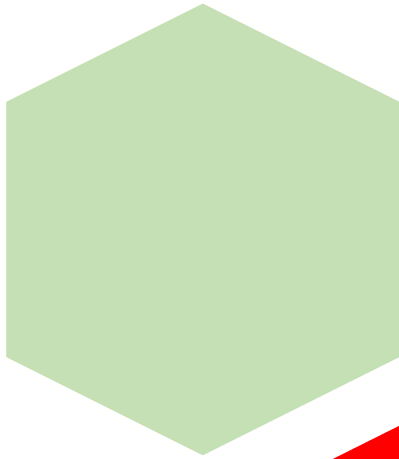

ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Gandhi Memorial National College, Ambala Cantt, popularly known as GMN College, has gained an exclusive reputation around the city and within the state, leading to its recognition as one of the most premier institutions offering higher academic learning at Undergraduate and Postgraduate courses. Originally established in Rawalpindi, (now in Pakistan), as D.A.V. College, it was re-established at Ambala Cantt in 1948 as G.M.N. College by a great visionary Sh. Jaswant Rai. Since then, the college has been playing a vital role in nurturing the young minds of the region. After humble beginnings of being housed in a modest building with thatched roofs, today it is located in a sprawling and beautiful campus spread over 9.5 acres and has over 1500 students on its rolls and a teaching and non-teaching staff of over 70. It offers 11 UG Programmes and 04 PG Programmes of study. The infrastructural facilities include a High-Tech Seminar Hall; separate Science, Commerce and Arts Blocks; a Language Lab; Artificial Intelligence Lab, a well-stocked Library equipped with KOHA-ILMS and well-equipped Laboratories. Besides, there are Departmental Rooms, Computer & Internet facilities, extensive Playgrounds, Canteen and Health-Care facilities. The college enjoys a coveted position in the field of academics, sports and co-curricular activities. Our students have brought laurels to the college in the fields of Academics, Sports, NCC and NSS by winning top positions. They are a living example of the famous saying: Come to Learn; Go to Serve. The college is very much aware of the fast-changing teaching-learning scenario globally and is fully equipped to incorporate them. COLLEGE LIBRARY

The Jaswant Rai Memorial Library of the college is the core of academic services, and therefore, become a key place in academic and research activities. Library has fully air-conditioned reading section with capacity of 100 students, separate electronic library, separate reading section for teachers, fully automation with KOHA ILMS. With its collection of more than 33000 text books, 4090 reference books, 609 CDs/DVDs, 17 Print journals, 25 Magazines/Periodicals, 8 different newspapers, it provides the ready to use information support to its users. Besides printed books and journals, central library collection includes thousands of e-Books, e-journals and open access e-resources. The Library can be accessed from the GMN College Main Website (www.gmncollegeambala.ac.in) under the Library Menu tab. The Library section on the college website is centrally designed to provide access to various types of contents such as KOHA ILMS Library Web-OPAC (Accessible 24*7 via Library menu on College website), subscribed E-resources [N-LIST Consortium & Pearson E-Books (Remote Access), Sage E-Books, Sage Journals (Campus-wide IP based access)] by the Library, open access e-resources, INFLIBNET Content (e-PG Pathshala, Shodh Ganga, Shodh Gangotri, Vidya Mirta), e- Gyankosh, National Digital Library of India (NDL), World Digital Library, UNESCO Digital Library, SWAYAM, NEPTTEL, edX, Coursera, Open Access e-Journals, e-Books, Hindi and Sanskrit e-resources, e-

newspaper, and 32 modules of EPWRF ITS Database, etc. Students and teachers can access all these e-resources at a single place under the library menu on the college website.

The academic session 2023-24 commenced with the performing of Havan by the members of the staff and students in the college auditorium followed by the prayer meet.









INDEPENDENCE DAY
